# WARWICKSHIRE RING - CLOCKWISE





# **Summary**

This is a trip of 104 miles, 3¾ furlongs and 121 locks from Coventry Road Bridge No 49 to Coventry Road Bridge No 49.

From Coventry Road Bridge No 49 travel west on the Grand Union Canal (Warwick and Napton Canal) for 1 mile, 4¾ furlongs and 2 locks to Budbrooke Junction, then travel northwest on the Grand Union Canal (Warwick and Birmingham Canal: widened section - Main Line) for 7 miles, 1¼ furlongs and 21 locks to Kingswood Junction, then travel northwest on the Stratford Canal (Kingswood Branch) for 3¼ furlongs and 5 locks to Lapworth Junction North, then travel northwest on the Stratford Canal (Northern Section) for 13 miles, 31/2 furlongs and 15 locks to King's Norton Junction, then travel north on the Worcester and Birmingham Canal (Birmingham to King's Norton) for 4 miles, 5 furlongs to Worcester Bar, then travel northwest on the Birmingham Canal Navigations (Main Line) for 2 furlongs to Deep Cuttings Junction, then travel northeast on the Birmingham Canal Navigations (Newhall Branch) for 6 furlongs and 12 locks to Farmer's Bridge Junction, then travel northeast on the Birmingham Canal Navigations (Birmingham and Fazeley Canal - Main Line) for 15 miles, 4¾ furlongs and 26 locks to Fazeley Junction, then travel southeast on the Coventry Canal (Main Line - Hawkesbury to Fazeley) for 20 miles, 1¾ furlongs and 13 locks to Hawkesbury Junction, then travel southeast on the Oxford Canal (Northern Section - Main Line) for 23 miles, 1¼ furlongs and 4 locks to Braunston Turn, then travel southwest on the Grand Union Canal (Oxford Canal Section) for 5 miles, ¼ furlongs to Napton Junction, then travel west on the Grand Union Canal (Warwick and Napton Canal) for 12 miles, 2¼ furlongs and 23 locks to Coventry Road Bridge No 49.

### Totals

Total distance is 104 miles, 3¾ furlongs and 121 locks. There are at least 7 moveable bridges of which 2 are usually left open; 27 small aqueducts or underbridges and 6 tunnels (Shrewley Tunnel (433 yards long), Brandwood Tunnel (352 yards long), Edgbaston Tunnel (105 yards long), Factory Tunnel, Curdworth Tunnel (57 yards long) and Newbold Tunnel (250 yards long)).

This is made up of 78 miles, 1/2 furlongs of narrow canals; 26 miles, 3/4 furlongs of broad canals; 75 narrow locks; 46 broad locks.

This will take 60 hours, 7 minutes which is 8 days, 4 hours and 7 minutes at 7 hours per day. You have asked for it to be done in 5 days, each of which will be 11 hours and 1 minute.

## Overnight stopping places

This is calculated based on 4 hours travelling before the first overnight stop, 5 full days travelling and 1 hour travelling on the last day starting at Coventry Road Bridge No 49.

On average each full day will be approximately 11 hours and 1 minute travelling but some overnight stops have been moved to avoid unsuitable stopping places and this has affected the lengths of the days. The shortest day is 9 hours and 53 minutes and the longest is 11 hours and 45 minutes (the maximum day-length is set at 10 hours).

## First day of trip

On the Grand Union Canal (Warwick and Birmingham Canal: widened section - Main Line), at Hatton Long Term Moorings (to avoid stopping in a flight of locks) (a third of the way between Hatton Top Lock No 46 and Shrewley Tunnel (Northwest end)). This is 3 miles, 6½ furlongs and 23 locks and will take 5 hours 7 minutes.

#### Second day of trip

On the Stratford Canal (Northern Section), at King's Norton Stop Lock No 1 (nearly at King's Norton Junction). This is 17 miles, 31/4 furlongs and 19 locks and will take 9 hours 54 minutes.

On the Birmingham Canal Navigations (Birmingham and Fazeley Canal - Main Line), at Curdworth Top Lock No 28 (to avoid stopping in a flight of locks) (nearly at Curdworth Lock 2 No 29). This is 15 miles, 7¼ furlongs and 28 locks and will take 10 hours 18 minutes.

# Fourth day of trip

On the Coventry Canal (Main Line - Hawkesbury to Fazeley), at Wood Bridge No 27. This is 19 miles, 3 furlongs and 24 locks and will take 11 hours 45 minutes.

# Fifth day of trip

On the Oxford Canal (Northern Section - Main Line), at Barby Straight Bridge No 77 (two thirds of the way between Kilsby Road Bridge No 74 and Navigation Bridge No 85). This is 25 miles, 4¼ furlongs and 4 locks and will take 11 hours 2 minutes.


On the Grand Union Canal (Warwick and Napton Canal), at Gulleman's Way Underbridge. This is 19 miles, ¾ furlongs and 23 locks and will take 11 hours 1 minute.

## Seventh day of trip

On the Grand Union Canal (Warwick and Napton Canal), at Coventry Road Bridge No 49. This is 3 miles, 21/2 furlongs and 0 locks

and will take 1 hour.
